I recently wrote and directed the movie *The Reckoning* (2014) starring Jonathan LaPaglia, Luke Hemsworth and Viva Bianca. Past films include *Needle* (2011) starring Travis Fimmel and Ben Mendelsohn and *Crush* (2009) starring Christopher Egan.

When we were casting *The Reckoning* I needed an actor to play alongside a "drug kingpin" character who needed to embody the sort of villain who had been toughened by years of working as an enforcer, yet possess his own unique and fresh faced charisma.
